
The Victorian Government has indicated that as of **11.59pm tonight, 26 February 2021** the State will return to eased restrictions and, in essence, the 'COVID-Safe Summer' rules.

This will mean:


- 1. Workplaces:** 75 percent of employees can attend the workplace, effectively starting Monday 1 March 2021 – in both the public and private sectors.
- 2. Homes:** can invite up to 30 visitors per day, from any number of households.
- 3. Masks:** must be carried at all times but will be compulsory in high-risk settings, including retail such as supermarkets and in shopping centres; on public transport; in taxis and ride shares; and in residential aged care settings. There is no requirement for school students to wear masks, but individual schools may make their own rules.
- 4. Public outdoor gatherings:** will be allowed of up to 100 people from any number of households.
- 5. Hospital and aged care visitors:** Restrictions on visitor numbers will be removed. Certain localised rules will apply in particular settings based on health requirements.
- 6. AFL games:** Fifty percent capacity crowds will be allowed to attend games from commencement of the football season.
